Details of the Early Childhood Enrichment program

Whether this is your child's first experience in a setting away from home or they are comfortable in a teacher led classroom, this class will be right for your child. Not only will your child be exposed to educational themes that are stimulating and age appropriate, but their social development will skyrocket with the carefully structured activities led each day.

Our program for children 2-3 yrs will provide your child with valuable classroom experience to help prepare them for more formal educational settings and more intricate lessons as they get older. Social development at this age is very important and many of our educational lessons are structured around social learning. You will see an improvement with speech, independence, responsibility and empathy to name a few. Listed below are some examples of the educational components you will see in this class:

Literacy: Daily story times, recognition and introduction to the alphabet with proper pronunciation, pre writing skills, recognizing beginning, middle and end of stories, and name recognition.

Math: daily counting and quantity, weight (heavier vs. lighter), shape recognition and labeling, beginning patterns, matching, and comparing and contrasting.

Social studies: community awareness to include introduction to the different types of community helpers, social constructs, imaginative exploration of careers, personal safety and responsibility as well.

Science: Experiences of basic science concepts like: cause and effect, states of matter, and observation and reasoning. Students will also experience nutrition education, basic human anatomy, life cycles, and physical education which will be experienced in our 7000sq. ft. Gymnastics facility and outdoor play yard.

Social/Life skills: Enhancing independence in areas such as clothing themselves, personal hygiene, using verbal and signed language to get needs met, sharing, taking turns, cleaning up after using the potty, character building, manners, and participation in all school activities.
